

## BALTIC STATES TABLE TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025 REGULATIONS

### 1. Authority

Estonian Table Tennis Association, under the authority granted by the Baltic Table Tennis Union, will organize Baltic States Table Tennis Championships 2025.

### 2. Date and Place

The Championships will be held in Märjamaa on **27-28.12.2025**, in the Märjamaa Sportcentre, Staadioni 3, Märjamaa.

### 3. Program of the Competitions

#### 3.1. Team events (closed competitions only for Estonian, Latvian and Lithuanian national teams).

A men's or women's team shall be the best of 5 singles. The team consists of 5 players but in one match can take part 3 players. The order of play shall be: A-X, B-Y, C-Z, A-Y and B-X. The match shall end when a team has won 3 individual matches. Team events will be played in round system. All individual matches in team events will be the best of 5 games.

#### 3.2 Individual events

Men's Singles and Women's Singles will be played in groups of 3-5 players (round Robin system). In group matches will be the best of 5 games. The two highest placed players from groups will form the final group, which will be competed in a knockout system without determination of the 3<sup>rd</sup> place. In the final group matches will be the best of 7 games.

## **5. Rules**

The Championships will be played in accordance with the Laws of TT and the Regulations for International competitions.

## **6. Equipment**

The following equipment will be used:

Tables: San-Ei/Tibhar Table SP Allstar ITTF (blue)

Ball: DHS 40+ \*\*\* (white)

## **7. Eligibility**

The team Championships will be open to teams and players nominated by Estonian Table Tennis Association, Table Tennis Federation of Latvia and Lithuanian Table Tennis Federation. TTF of Latvia and Lithuanian TTF have the right to nominate 1 Men's and 1 Women's teams (each consisting of 5 players) and up to 6 players in Men's and Women's singles events. Estonian TTA has the right to nominate 2 Men's and 2 Women's teams and up to 12 players in Men's and Women's singles events.

## **8. Submission of entries**

## **9. Umpires**

Qualified umpires of Estonian TTA and invited umpires from Latvia and Lithuania (one from each country) will control all team matches. Referee: Allar Vellner (NU).

## **10. Hospitality**

Estonian Table Tennis Association will provide free accommodation for 1 night (27/28.12.2025) and meals from lunch 27.12.2025 until lunch 28.12.2025 up to 3 men, 3 women players, 1 umpire, and 2 coaches of TTF of Latvia and Lithuanian TTF, and all expenses connected with organization of the Championships.

Costs for additional players with accommodation and meals – 100.00 EUR (per person, per 2 days (1 night), including entry fee for individual event). Entry fee for individual event without accommodation – 30.00 EUR for all players who don't have free hospitality.

Extra night (26/27.12.2025) – 45 EUR (only accommodation – no meals)

**Accommodation of the participants will be in Märjamaa Sportscentre, Staadioni 3, Märjamaa, Estonia.**
